RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education Class Times:

First Communion will be held on May 10th, 2014. Confirmation will be held on May 15th, 2014. Parents, please bring a copy of your child's baptism certificate at the time of registration. A \$25.00 retreat fee is also due at registration.
