## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

### Religious Education Class Times:

To ensure the safety of all children, please pick up your child from Middle School activity promptly at 8:15PM.**

**Catechetical Sunday will be celebrated on September 15th.** Teachers will be commissioned during the 8:30 & 11:00AM Mass. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Please keep our OLOL Catechists in your prayers throughout the year.

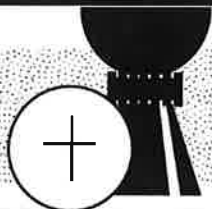
