School supplies: Pencils, pens, chalk, colored pencils, rulers, composition notebooks, handheld or crank style pencil sharpeners, geometry math tools, scissors, makers, sharpies, paper clips. No crayons please, they melt.

School lunch supplies: Melamine or plastic bowls, plates, and cups. Metal spoons and forks.

Clothing: flip flops, sandals, closed toe shoes and athletic shoes- all sizes. New or gently used summer clothes: t-shirts, shorts, short sleeved and sleeveless shirts, light weight pants- all sizes male, female, baby. Girls and boys underwear all sizes .Infant onesies and blankets

Miscellaneous: Toothbrushes and paste. Bar soap, hand sanitizer, deodorant .Toys trucks, baby dolls, soccer balls, heavy duty playground balls. Music equipment: 12 channel mixer, 2 speakers, 2 microphones, tambourines .Prescription eyeglasses Small plastic film canisters.

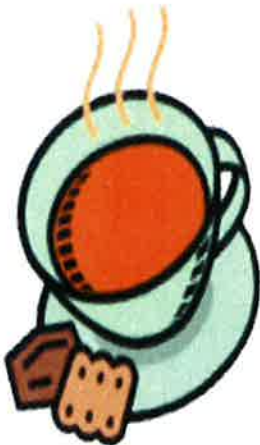
