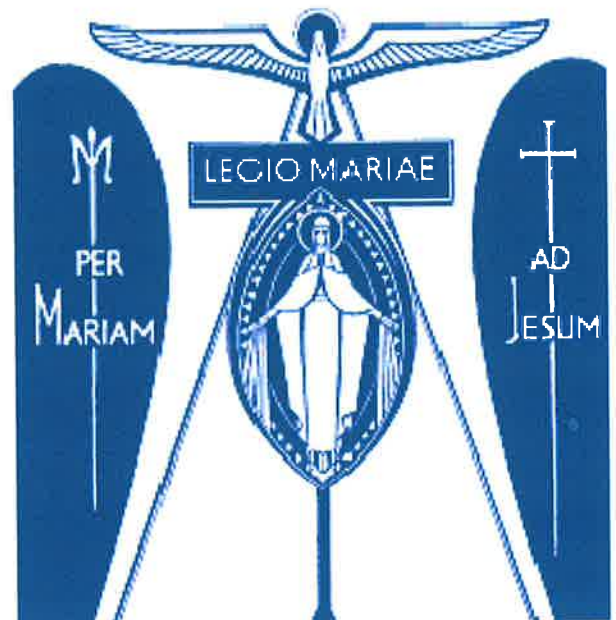


October Rosary Walk And Legion of Mary Retreat

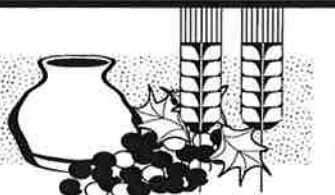
