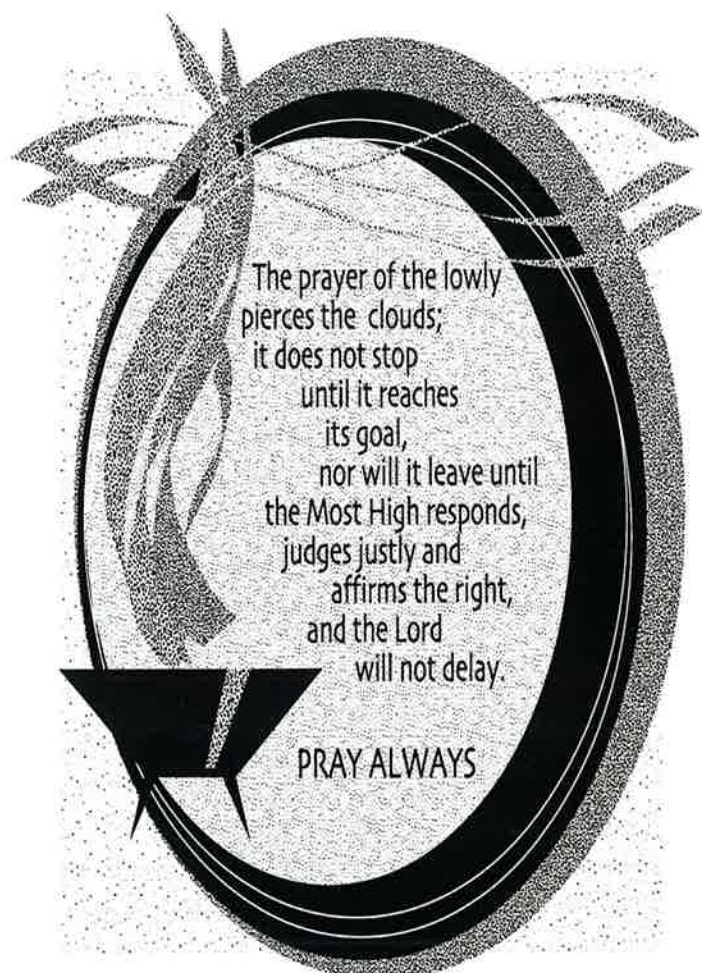
**Special Collection to Ensure the Future of Our Local Church**

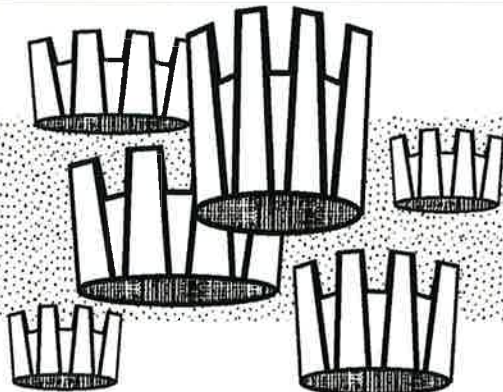

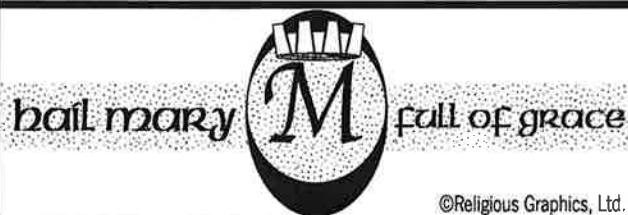
