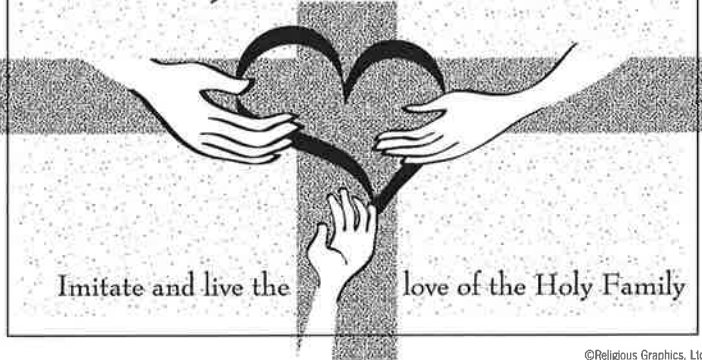

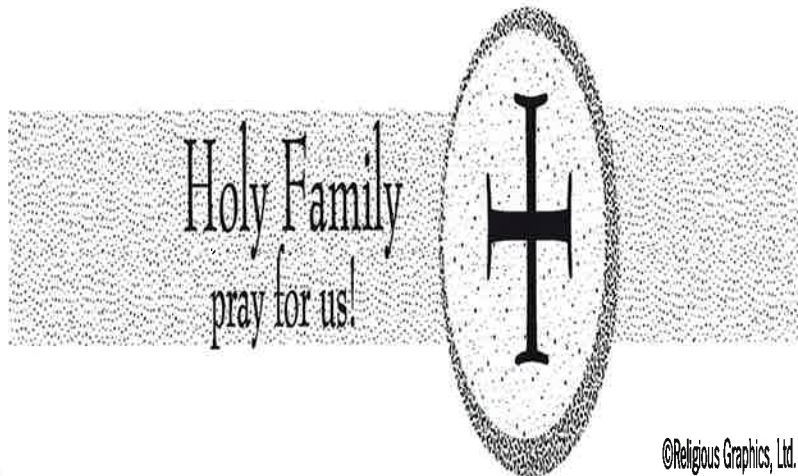
CLASS TIMES:
