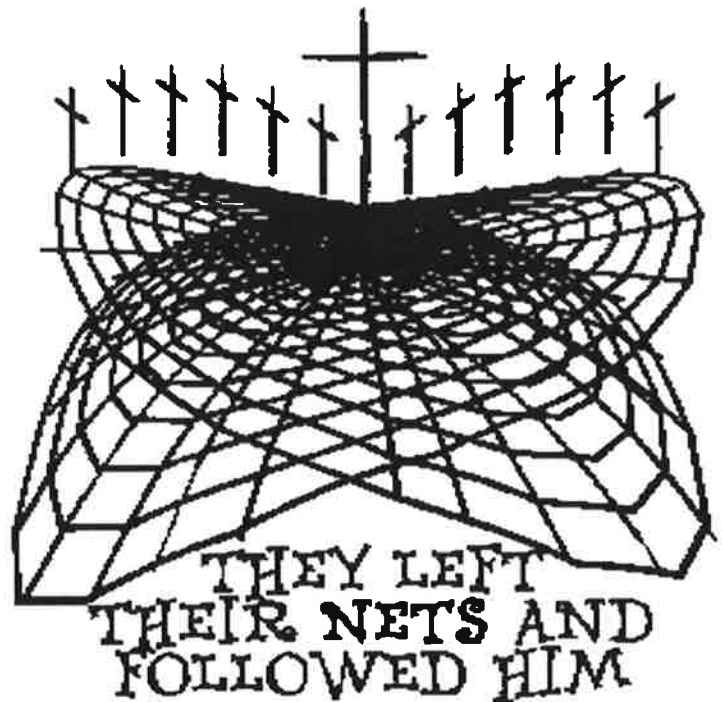
Home Maintenance Help

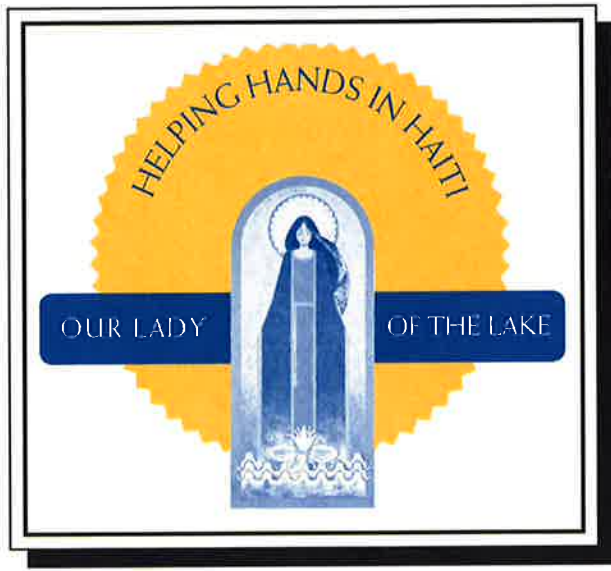

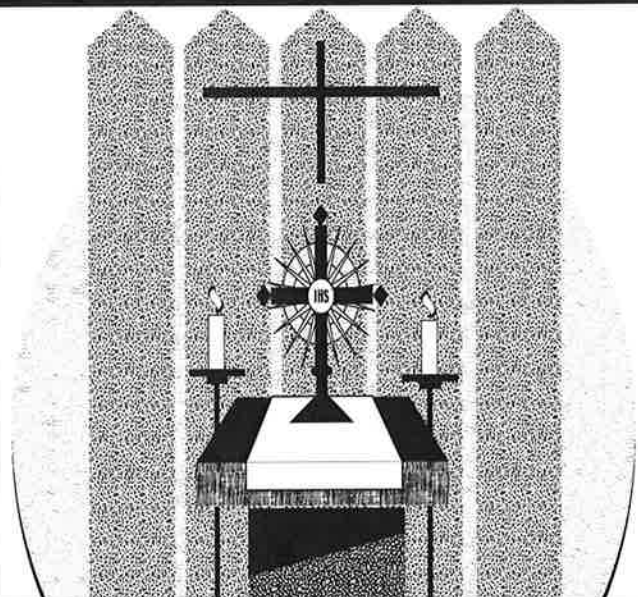

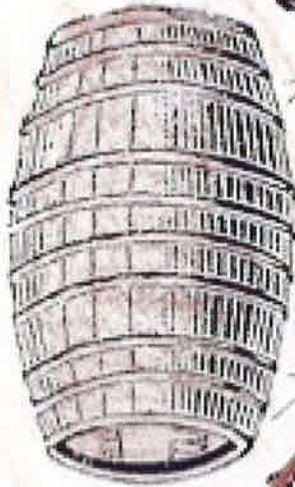
