Home Maintenance Help

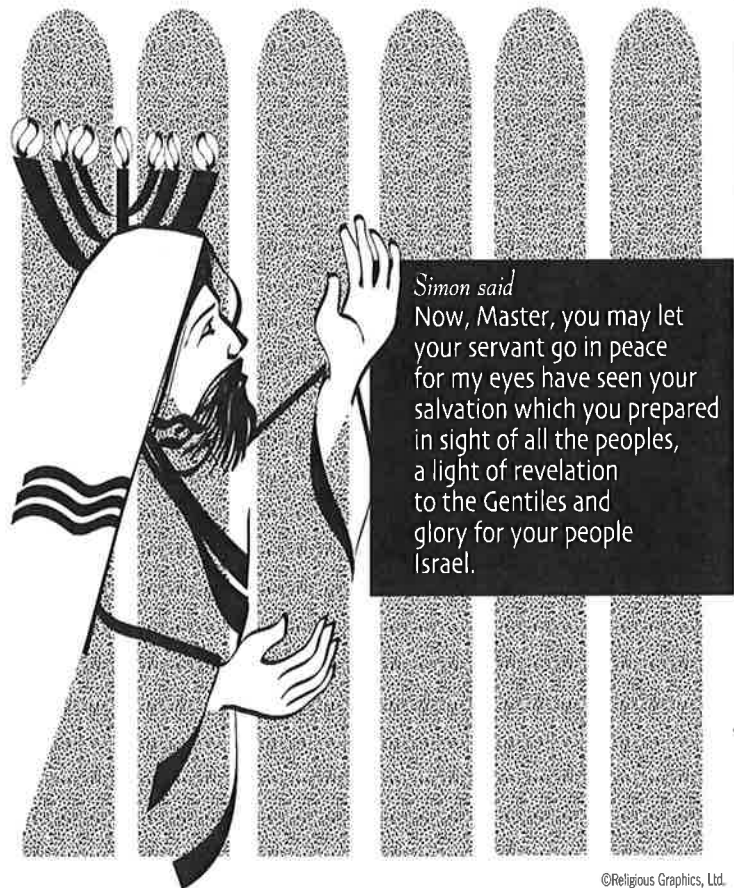

Catholic Homeschool Conference—March 14th, 2014

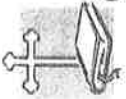
