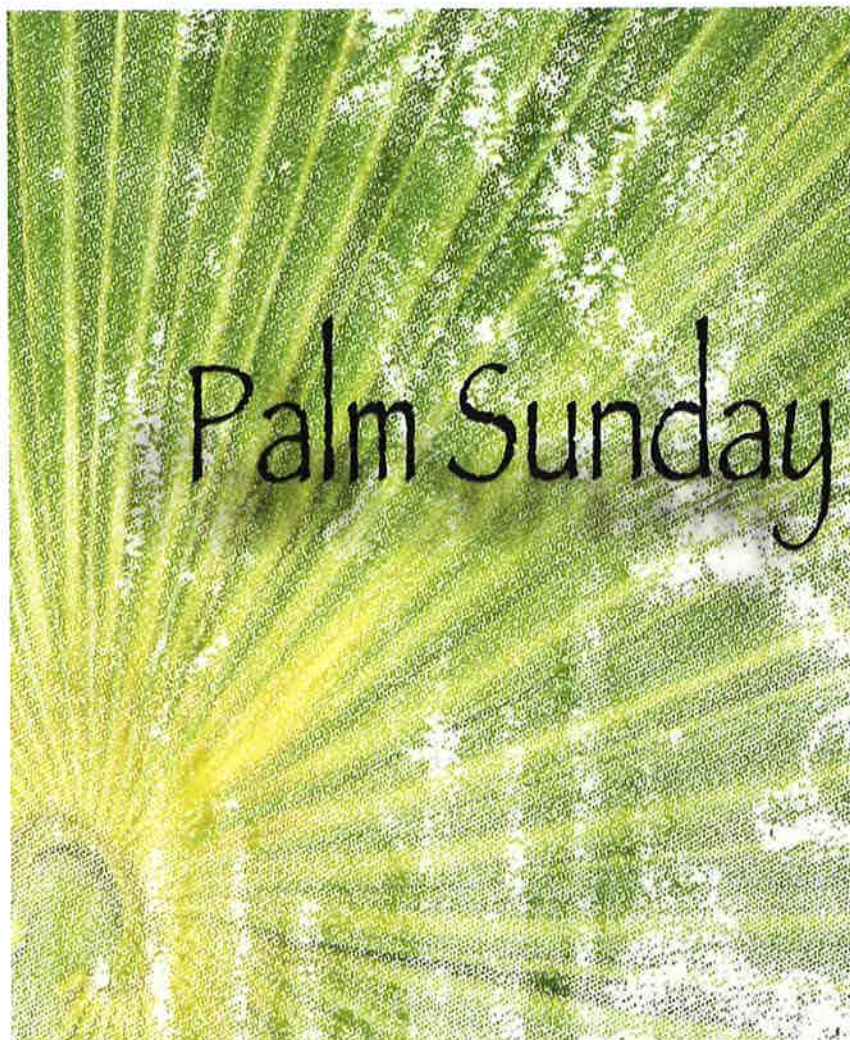

For the safety of our children and due to limited staff in the nursery, we would like to remind everyone of the following nursery rules:

- The nursery is for children 0-3 yrs of age only. Children 4 & over or siblings of younger children in the nursery are not permitted due to limited staff.
- NO food or drink is allowed in the nursery
- Please follow the check-in process when dropping off your child: Sign them in and include your cell phone number, label their bag, write their name on a tag/tape and apply it to their back.
- The door to the nursery must remain closed at ALL times. Please do not leave the door open while you are coming in & out or signing in your child. Small children can escape unnoticed when this happens.
- Please monitor your cell phone during Mass. This is how staff will reach you if needed.
- Please take conversations with other adults out into the hall in order to keep the nursery less crowded.

Unfortunately the nursery has limited openings each Sunday because the number of volunteers varies. Due to this, you may be denied nursery services. Please arrive early to insure a spot.

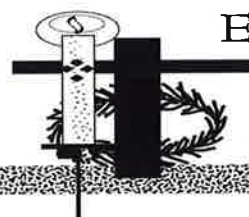


