RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Confirmation rehearsal: May 14th, 6:15PM in the Main Worship. There will be no Mass on this evening. Students and Sponsors are required to attend. If a Sponsor is not available for rehearsal, at least one parent of the Confirmand should attend the rehearsal.

Confirmation is scheduled for May 15th at 6:30PM. Confirmands and sponsors are required to meet in the Narthex at 6:00PM. A reception will follow the ceremony in the social hall.

Confirmation Dress Code: Because of the special nature of the occasion, and the spirituality of the place, dress for the confirmation ceremony should reflect the importance of the moment.

Girls: Dresses which cover the shoulders and come down to a respectable length near the knee in white or pastel colors. Pantsuits may also be worn. Modest, simple clothing with no large jewelry, pantyhose with dress shoes.

Boys: Collared long sleeve shirts with appropriate tie. Dress slacks with dress shoes and socks. No tennis shoes.

Sponsors should abide by the same dress code.

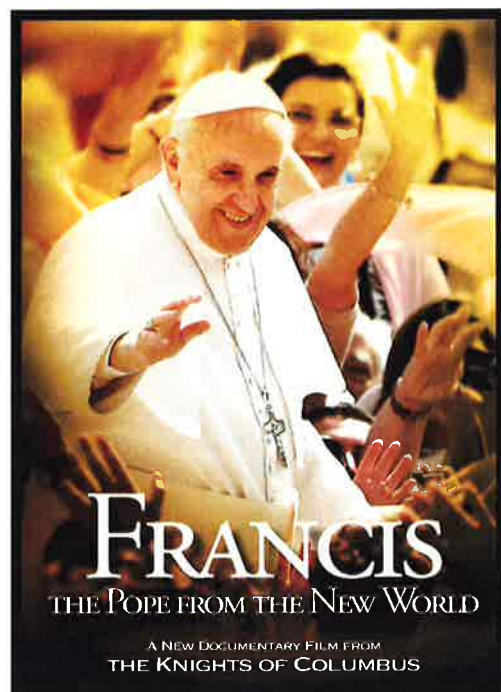
