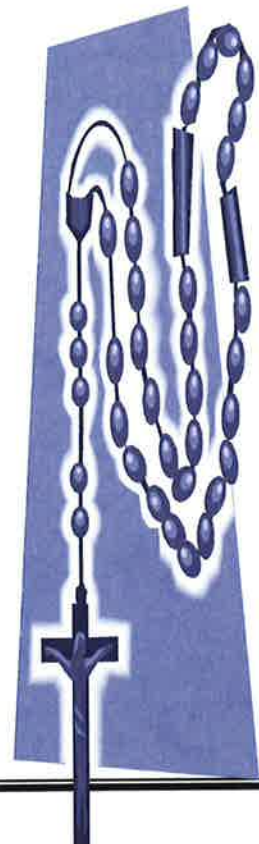
Intentions: We always pray for our own intentions and healing of our sick plus the general intentions listed for each month:


