Dear Our Lady of the Lake parishioners:

I am pleased to update you on the Forward in Faith capital campaign and our progress on the building expansion project.

To date, we have received \$5,114,715 in pledges, and we have collected \$1,206,800 in cash donations. I want to personally thank everyone – more than 900 parish families – who made a pledge or gift to the campaign. Also, I would like to thank the volunteers – more than 160 individuals – whose hard work made the success of the campaign possible.

Moving forward, for your convenience all families who made a pledge will receive reminder letters based on your stated preference for making payments or at least twice a year in June and November.

We are now financially ready to move forward with our vision for the future to add needed classrooms and meeting space, a new, large multi-purpose hall, additional office and storage space, and extra parking capacity and improved traffic flow.

The Diocese has approved our project, so now we are preparing to begin construction of our new facilities. Our contractor, Carter Group, and our architect, Hart Freeland Roberts, are in the process of developing construction drawings, identifying subcontractors and obtaining approvals from local authorities. We expect to break ground on the project sometime this fall. I look forward to celebrating that exciting and significant milestone with all of you.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask. Our Lady of the Lake is a vibrant, faith-filled parish, and I am honored to be your pastor.

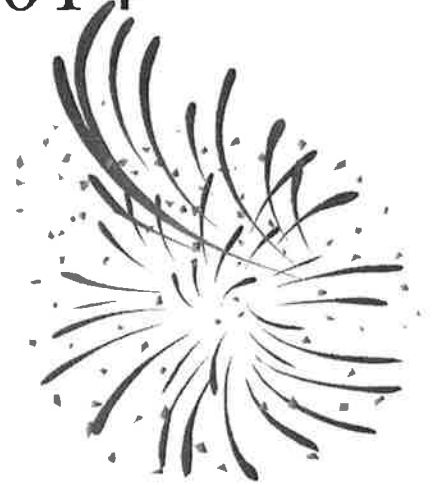
