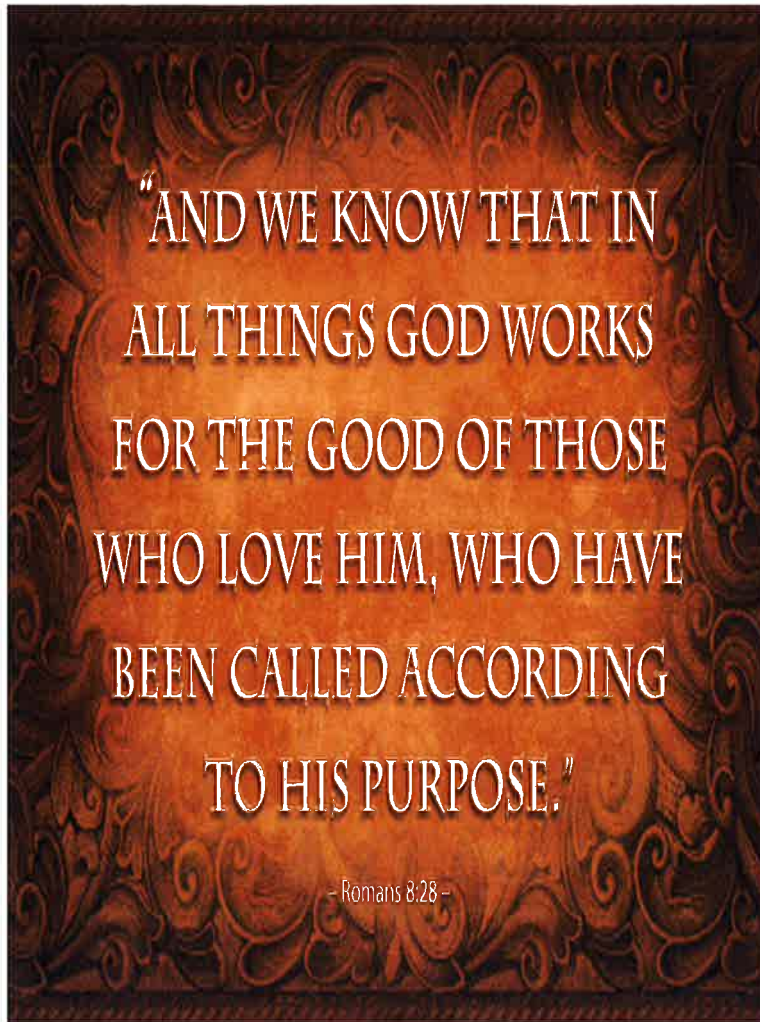

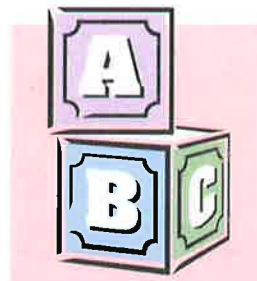

Nursery News

The nursery team is working on several enhancements over the summer to improve health & safety for our children.

Effective September 7, all families that utilize the nursery on Sunday will need to register and complete a registration and emergency information form. This

includes families utilizing the nursery during the following times on Sun: 8:30am & 11am Masses, while teaching Religious Ed, & while attending RCIA.

Registration is free. Forms will be available at the nursery, in the Welcome packet, from the church office, or on the church website. Also, to make it convenient for families enrolling other children in Religious Ed, nursery registration will be available during Religious Ed registration at the following times: July 30th & July 31 (times TBD) & after Sunday Masses in August

Also effective this fall in an attempt to align ourselves with Religious Ed, your child must be 3 or under to attend nursery. Our birthday cutoff will be September 30. If your child is 3 AFTER September 30, we welcome them in the nursery. If your child is 3 BEFORE September 30th, please enroll them in Religious Ed or have them attend Mass. Please see the bulletin for Religious Ed enrollment information.

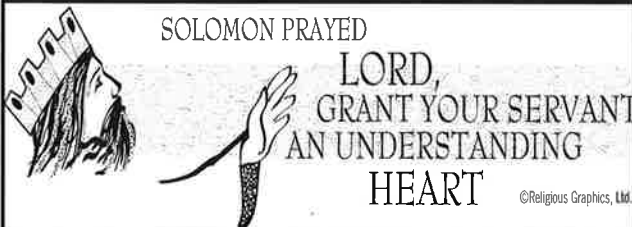
