First-Fifth Grade: 8:20 AM- 9:30 AM Sunday morning, also 9:40-10:50 AM Sunday mornings.

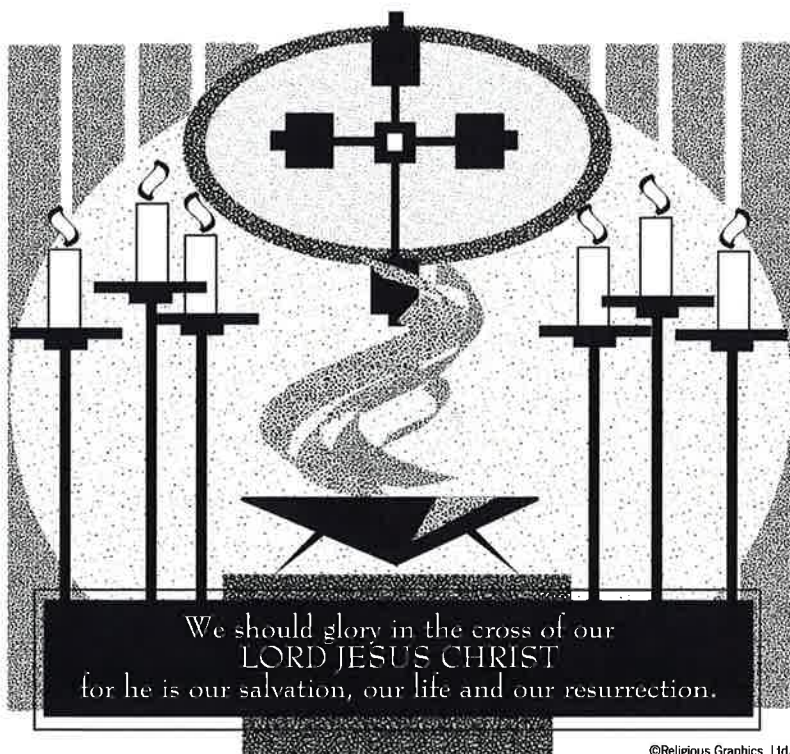
Sixth-Eighth Grade –Wednesday evenings 6:15 PM-7:45 PM

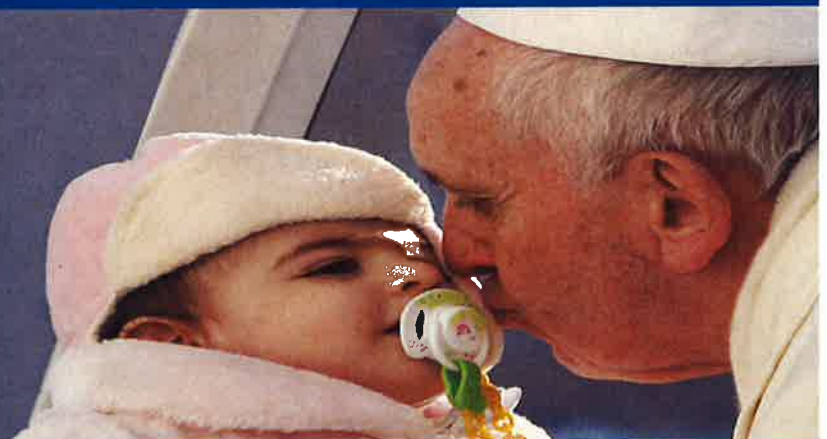

AMENDMENT 1 LANGUAGE
