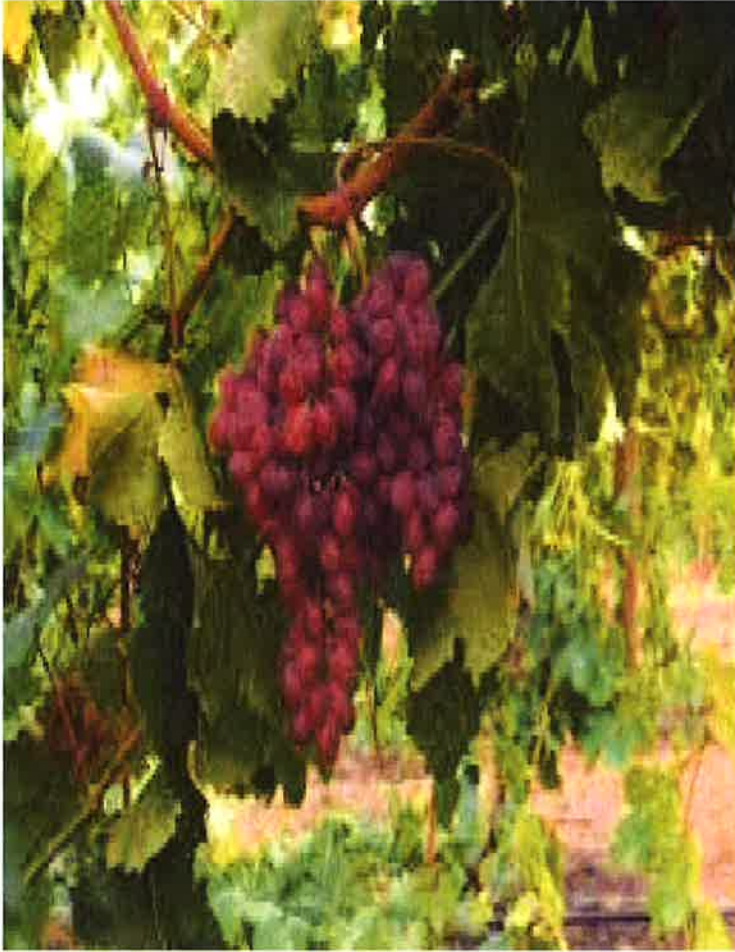

The Silver Rose of Our Lady of Guadalupe

On Tuesday, October 7th the Knights of Columbus will be presenting a beautiful Silver Rose for veneration in the main sanctuary at seven o'clock. All are welcome. If you are wondering what this is all about let me first give you a little background about the significance of the rose.

Our Lady of Guadalupe

During a walk from his home village to Mexico City early on the morning of December 9, 1531, the peasant Juan Diego saw a vision of a young girl of fifteen or sixteen, surrounded by light, on the slopes of the Hill of Tepeyac. The Lady asked for a church to be built at that site in her honor, and from her words Juan Diego recognized her as the Virgin Mary. Diego told his story to the Spanish bishop, who instructed him to return and ask the Lady for a miraculous sign to prove her claim. The Virgin told Juan Diego to gather some flowers from the top of Tepeyac Hill. It was winter and no flowers bloomed, but on the hilltop Diego found, in the frozen earth, a miraculous garden of roses not native to the area, and the Virgin herself arranged them in his cloak. When Juan Diego opened the cloak before the bishop the flowers fell to the floor, and in their place was the Virgin of Guadalupe, miraculously imprinted on the fabric. The image and the cloak are displayed for the veneration of the faithful to this day at the Cathedral of Mexico City. The subsequent church that was built and this apparition of the Blessed Virgin were greatly responsible for the conversion of millions of people in Mexico and Central America to the Catholic Faith and helped to bring an end to the pagan worship and human sacrifice that had been practiced by the Aztec people.

The Silver Rose

The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program began in 1960 as a project of the Knights of Columbus to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. Each year, the Silver Rose honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

One Life, One Rose

In recent years Knights of Columbus Supreme Knight, Carl Anderson has rededicated the Silver Rose to also serve as a symbol of our commitment to the sanctity of human life. In light of our current Yes on 1 amendment there has never been a more urgent need for prayer to bring about an end to the atrocities that pervade our culture today. We are asking everyone to pray through the intercession of Our Blessed Mother Mary to bring this message of One Life-One Rose to the forefront so that we may once again restore the sanctity of all life to its proper place in Tennessee, and the nation, as well.
