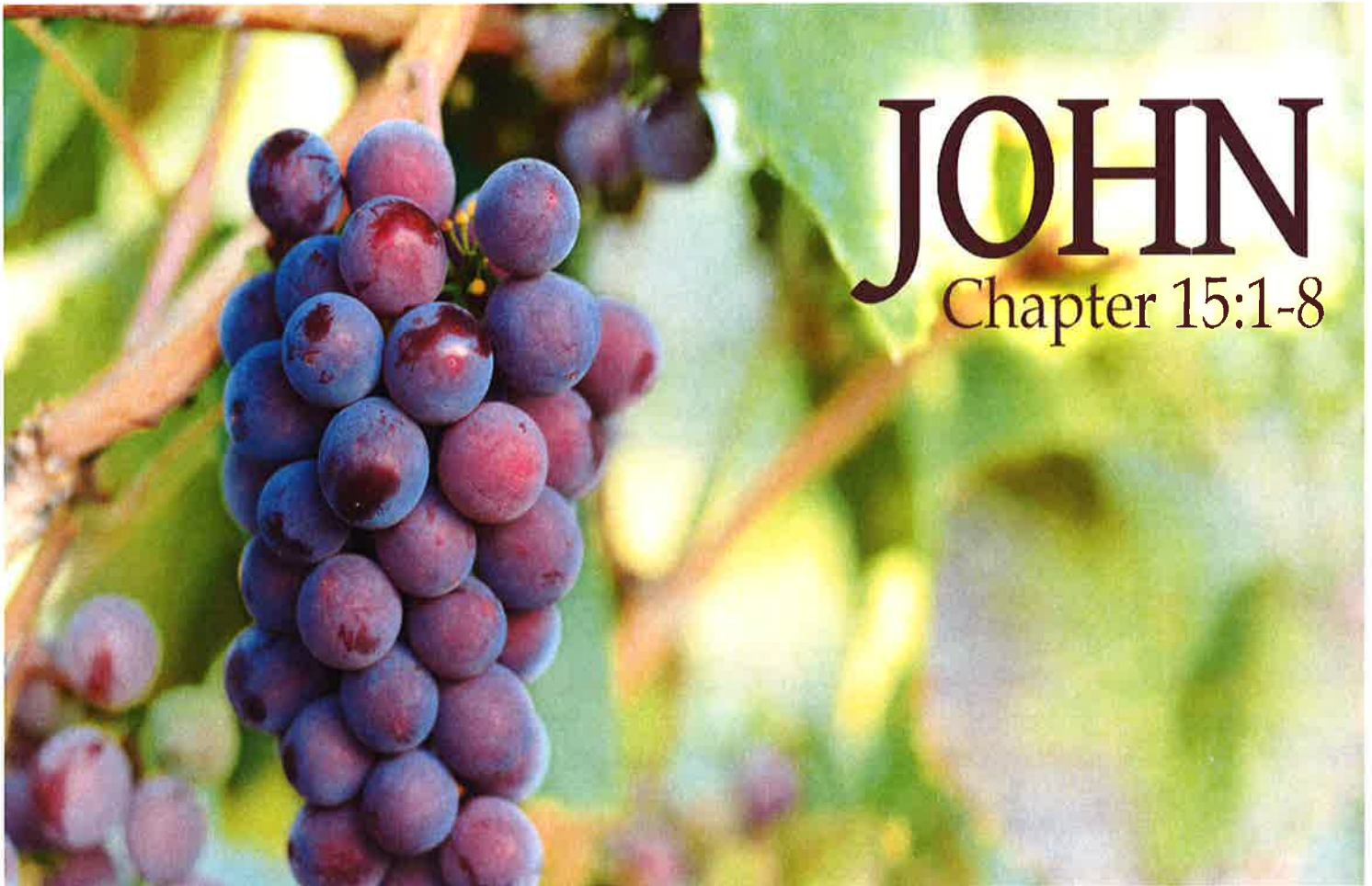

The 8:20 a.m. session will not have class on this day, but will meet in the Main Worship for practice at 9:40AM **First Communion rehearsal** is also scheduled for all students on Friday, May 8, 2015 at 5:30PM in the Main Worship.
