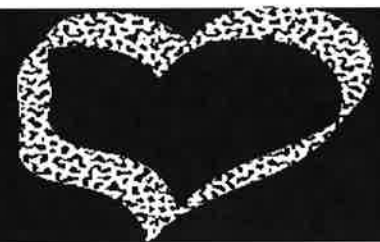
Eucharistic Adoration

Religious Education

First Communion: Congratulations to all the children and their families who celebrated First Communion on Saturday, May 9th. Thank you to our Catechists, Christopher Gunn and the Choir, Altar Servers Lilly and Seth Manor, and all those who helped serve at the reception.

Confirmation: Is scheduled for May 14, 2015 at 7:00 PM. Students and Sponsors are required to be here at 6:30PM. Confirmation rehearsal is scheduled for May 13, 2015 at 6:15PM. The Confirmation Student and Sponsors are required to attend the rehearsal. If the Sponsor is unable to attend the rehearsal, at least one parent with the student being Confirmed should attend. There will be no Youth Mass on May 13, 2015 due to Confirmation rehearsal.

Confirmation Dress Code

For Girls: Dresses should cover the shoulder and come down to a respectable length near the knee in white or pastel colors. (modest, simple clothing with no large jewelry) Pantyhose and dress shoes.

For Boys: Collared long sleeve dress shirts, (white or pastel in color) with appropriate tie and khaki or dress slacks with dress shoes; no tennis/jogging shoes.

Sponsors should abide by this same dress code.

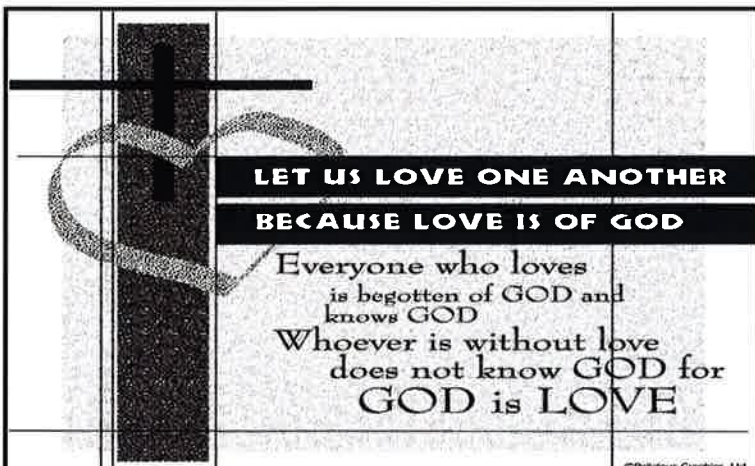
