The **Notre Dame du Lac Legion of Mary** will be our guest speaker and will provide a historical and informative explanation of the Legion of Mary.

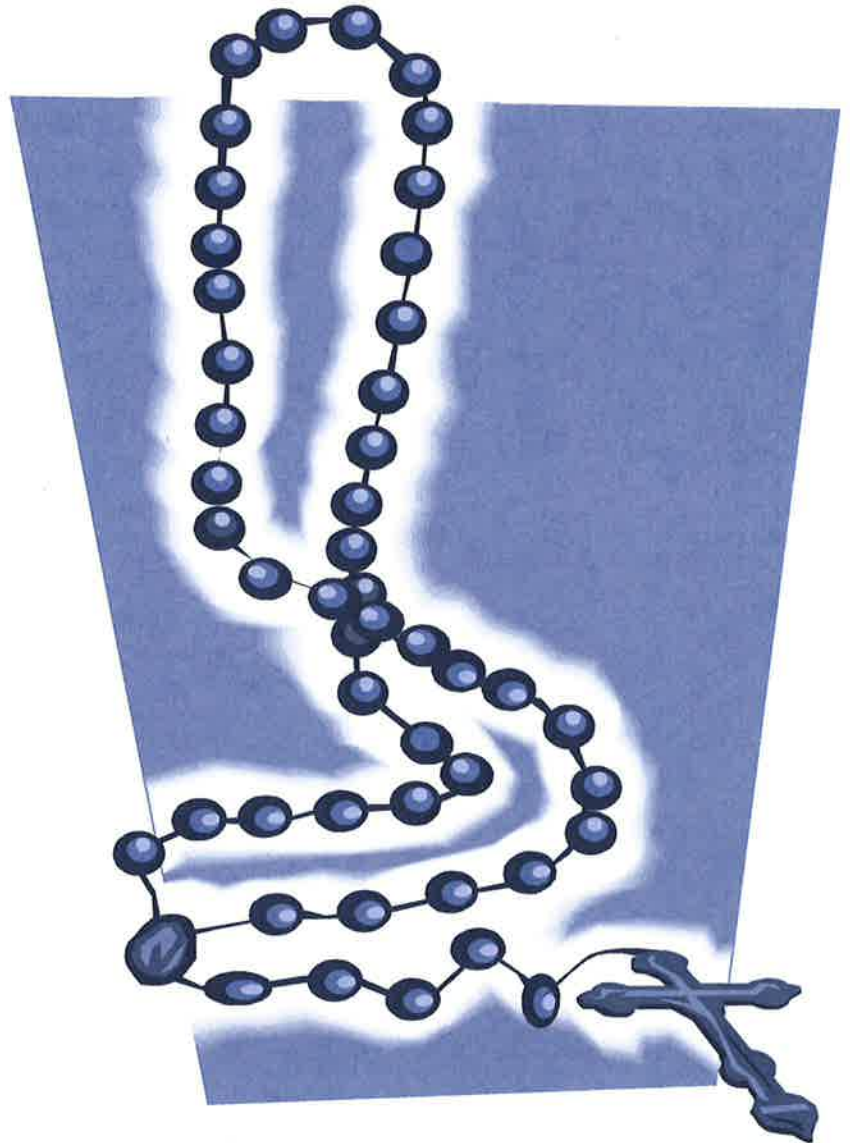

Confirmation Students: Confirmation students are invited to attend Life-Teen on Wednesday, May 20th at 6:15 p.m. Please meet in the Narthex.

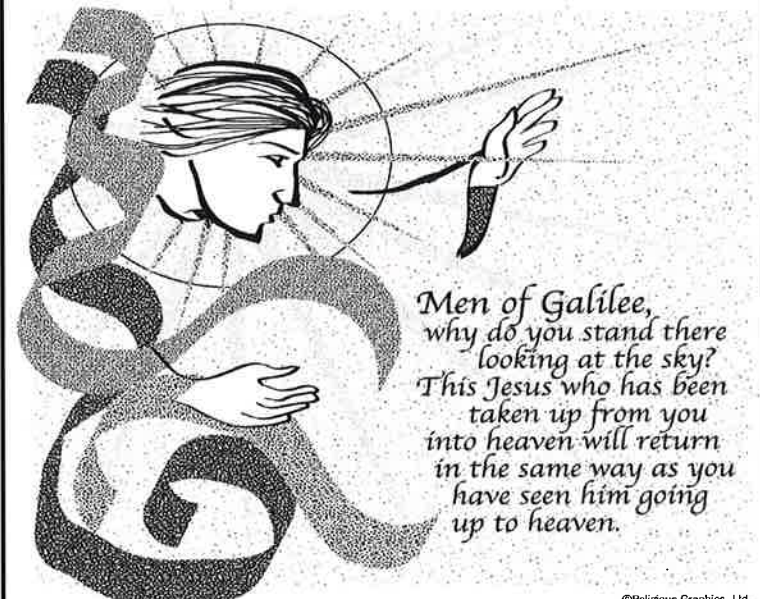
