Eucharistic Adoration

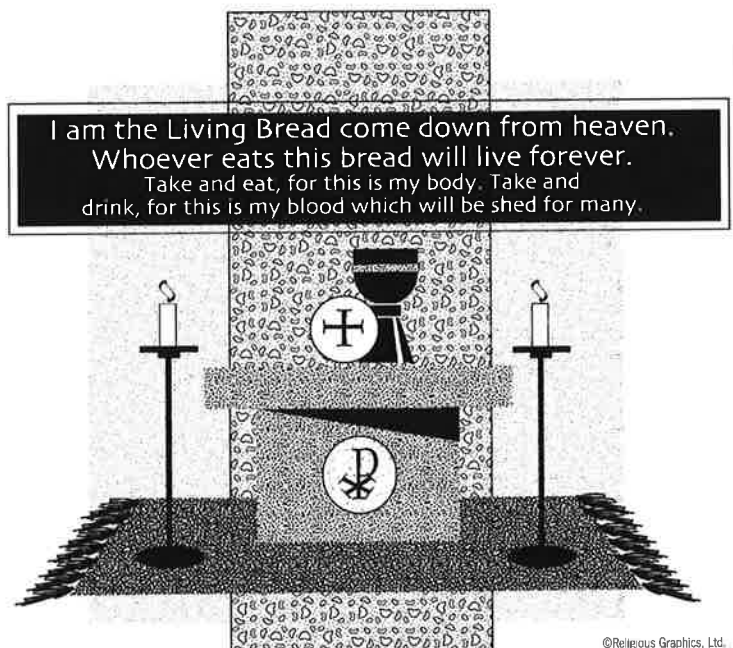

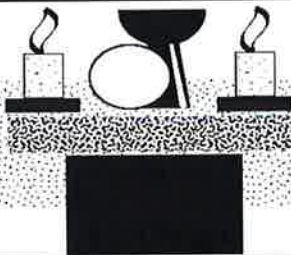
