AN INVITATION TO RCIA

On Sunday, September 13th, the RCIA (The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will begin. We will meet every Sunday, 9:40-10:45AM (between the Masses). Anyone interested in **learning about the Catholic Church or in joining the Church** at the Easter Vigil is welcome to attend. Unbaptized persons as well as those individuals baptized into another denomination may participate. Also, those older Catholic adolescents (not enrolled in 8th grade religious education) ages 12-17, and adult Catholics not yet confirmed, are accepted into the process.

Some topics discussed are: The 7 Sacraments; Mary, Mother of Jesus; Catholic Rituals and Customs; the Mass; the Bible; and Essential Catholic Beliefs.

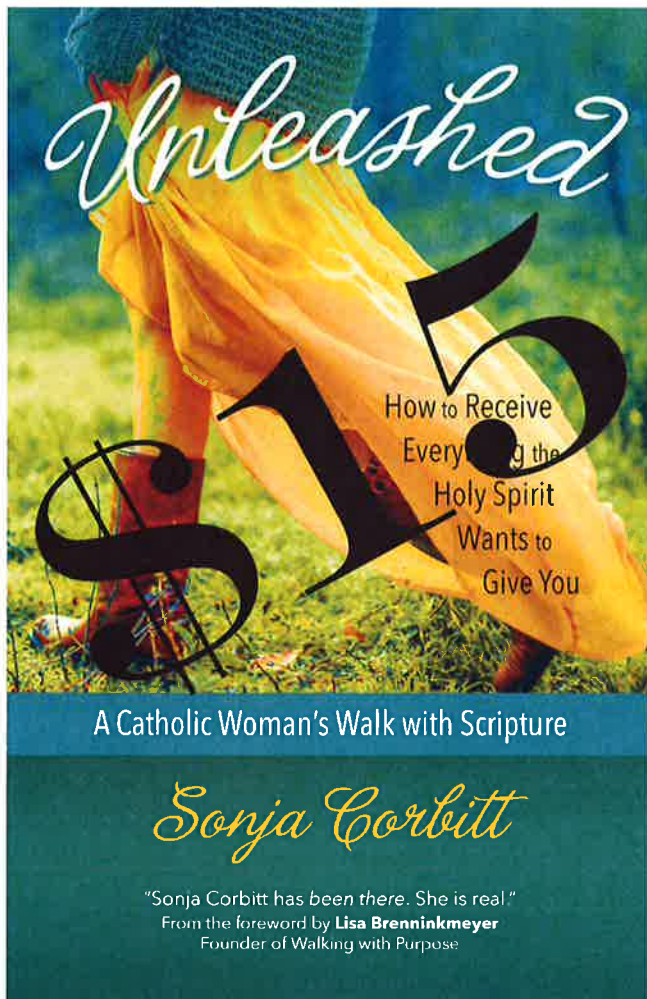
