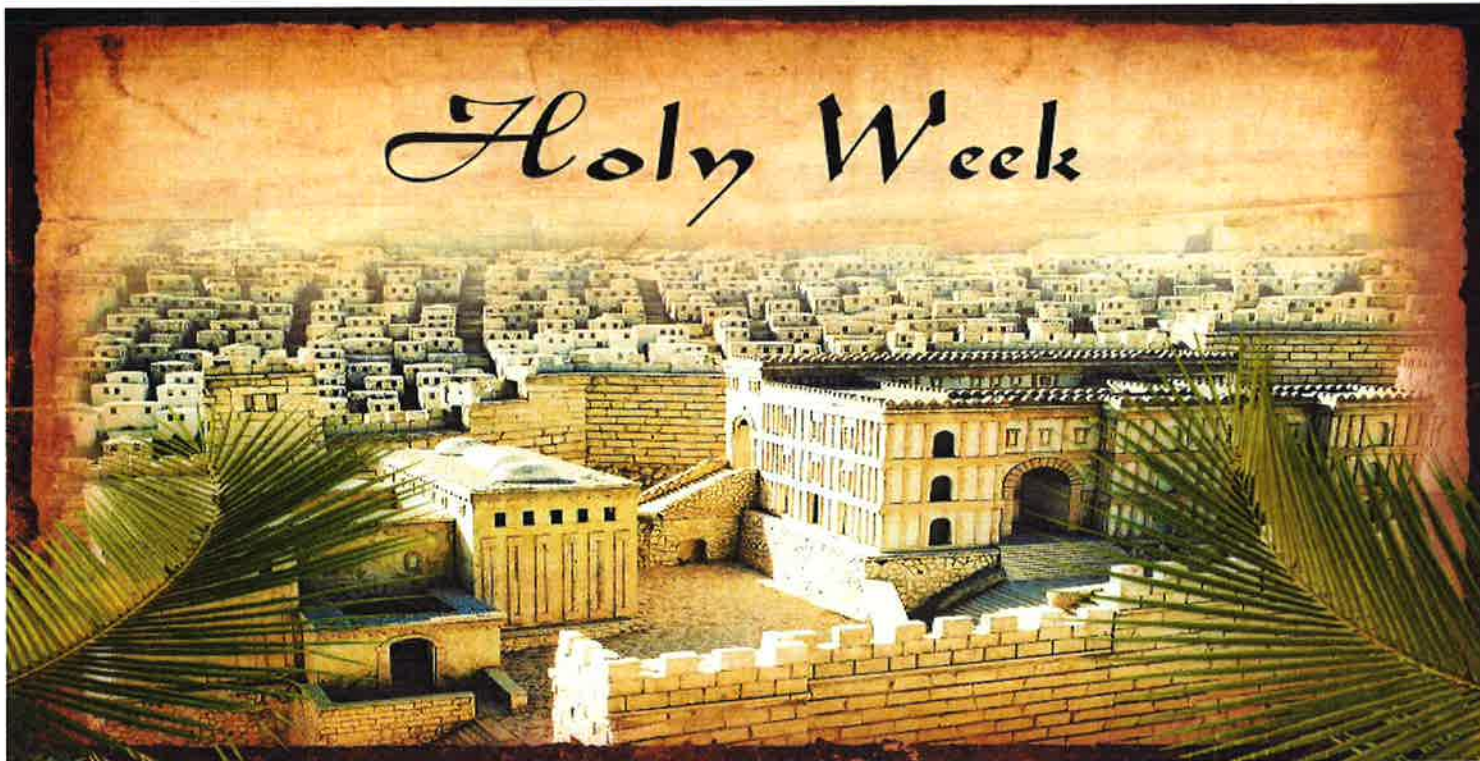

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Celebrate with us at Our Lady of the Lake
April 3 at 3:00pm

In His revelations to St. Faustina Kowalska, Jesus Christ asked that the first Sunday after Easter be established as Mercy Sunday, the "Feast of Divine Mercy," when His graces will be available in an extraordinary way to all those who ask. On Sunday, April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II formally announced that the Sunday after Easter would henceforth be known as "Divine Mercy Sunday". Jesus said to St. Faustina, "On that day, the depths of My mercy will be open to all. Whoever will go to confession and Holy Communion on that day will receive complete forgiveness of sin and punishment." What better time to experience this celebration than in the Church's Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy?

Please join us for a **Celebration of Divine Mercy at 3:00pm on Sunday, April 3.** In preparation for the celebration and to receive the graces promised by Christ, we should go to reconciliation before the feast day, receive Eucharist on the feast, venerate the image of Divine Mercy, place our trust in Jesus and be merciful to others through our actions, words and prayers. Our celebration will include veneration of the Image, Exposition and Benediction of the Eucharist and praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. A novena begins on Good Friday and pamphlets will be available in the narthex and adoration chapel.

Jubilee Year of Mercy

March 20, 2016

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Misericordiae Vultus: The Face of Mercy is Pope Francis' official decree announcing this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*. But Francis had already declared that Jesus "has shown the face of God's mercy" back in 2013 on his first Palm Sunday as pope. Francis described Luke's account of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem: "Crowds, celebrating, praise, blessing, peace: joy fills the air. Jesus has awakened great hopes, especially in the hearts of the simple, the humble, the poor, the forgotten, those who do not matter in the eyes of the world. He understands human sufferings . . . has bent down to heal body and soul." Entering Jerusalem, Jesus looks at all of us with love, Francis continued, at our sicknesses and sins. "A beautiful scene, full of light—the light of the love of Jesus" (Pope Francis, Palm Sunday homily, March 24, 2013). May this Jubilee Year's Holy Week and Triduum make us Jesus' own light-bearers and love-givers to all who long to see the Face of Mercy.
