## **Room in the Inn – Fall 2016**

Every year on the Sundays from November to March, Our Lady of the Lake hosts 15 homeless men from the Room in the Inn program. This is a big program that takes many volunteers. The main person that headed the program for our church has decided to step down. This year we will be changing how we run the Room in the Inn program with our volunteers just a bit. In efforts to make the Room in the Inn not be such a burden on those involved, we will divide out the main responsibilities as follows:

**Room in the Inn Director** – this person will be in charge overall, all managers will report to the director. The director is also in charge of main communications regarding the program to the church, to the Social Action chair and with Room in the Inn in Nashville. He/she will also be responsible for arranging the bus/transportation for the Room in the Inn guests and handle the background checks on all volunteers.

**Innkeeper manager** – this person will be in charge of recruiting, training and maintaining the innkeeper staff at all Room in the Inn weekends. All innkeepers will report to this person for any issues in scheduling.

**Teams manager** – this person will be in charge of recruiting and building teams, and creating schedules. All student helpers will also report to this person and must sign up at the beginning of the season to help. Only those that have signed up will be allowed be scheduled.

**Donations manager** - this person will be in charge of all donations including clothing, toiletries, food such as coffee and sausage from the religious education classes.

We will have an informational meeting on Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 9:45AM in Rooms 206 and 207. Please come if you are interested in this worthy ministry. If you have any questions or cannot make the meeting, please contact Christina Rader at (615)672-2666.

**Jubilee Year of Mercy**

**May 22, 2016**

**Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**

The word *mercy*, Pope Francis declared in his announcement of the *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, “reveals the very mystery of the Most Holy Trinity” (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 2). For *mercy* is how God comes to meet us; *mercy* is the fundamental law helping us recognize everyone as brothers and sisters; *mercy* is the bridge connecting God and humanity, opening our hearts to the hope of being loved forever despite our sinfulness. God’s self-revelation as a life-giving, love-sharing Trinity of Persons draws us closer to God in friendship and communion. Both Judaism and Islam consider *mercy* one of God’s most important attributes. Israel unceasingly proclaims God boundless in mercy. Islam addresses the Creator as “Merciful and Kind,” believing divine mercy limitless, its doors always open. May this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, Pope Francis prays, open us to more fervent dialogue, deepen our mutual understanding, eliminate all closed-minded disrespect, and drive out every form of violence and discrimination.

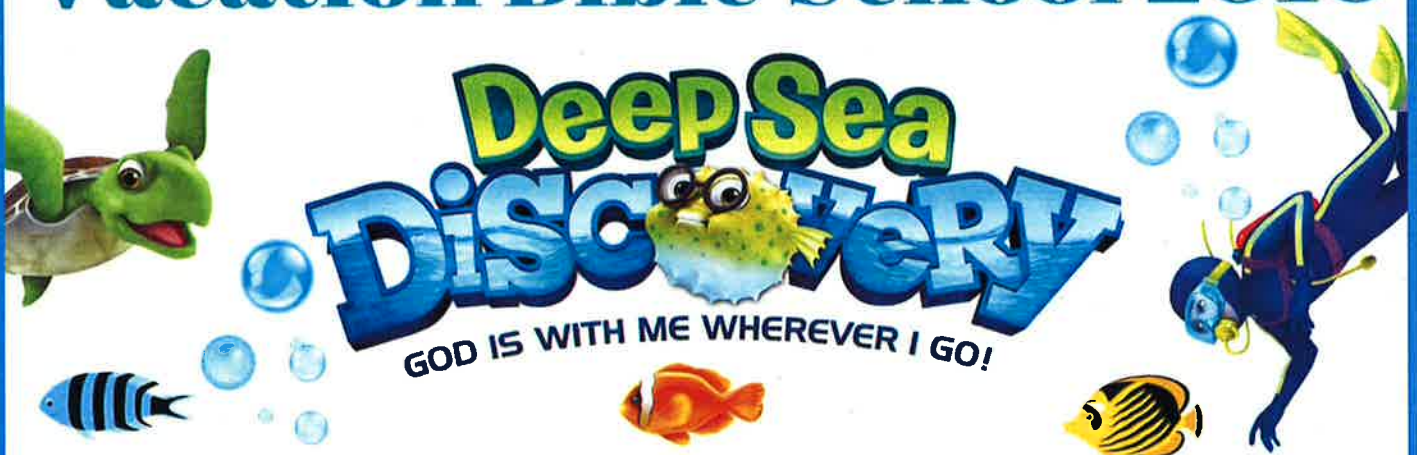
