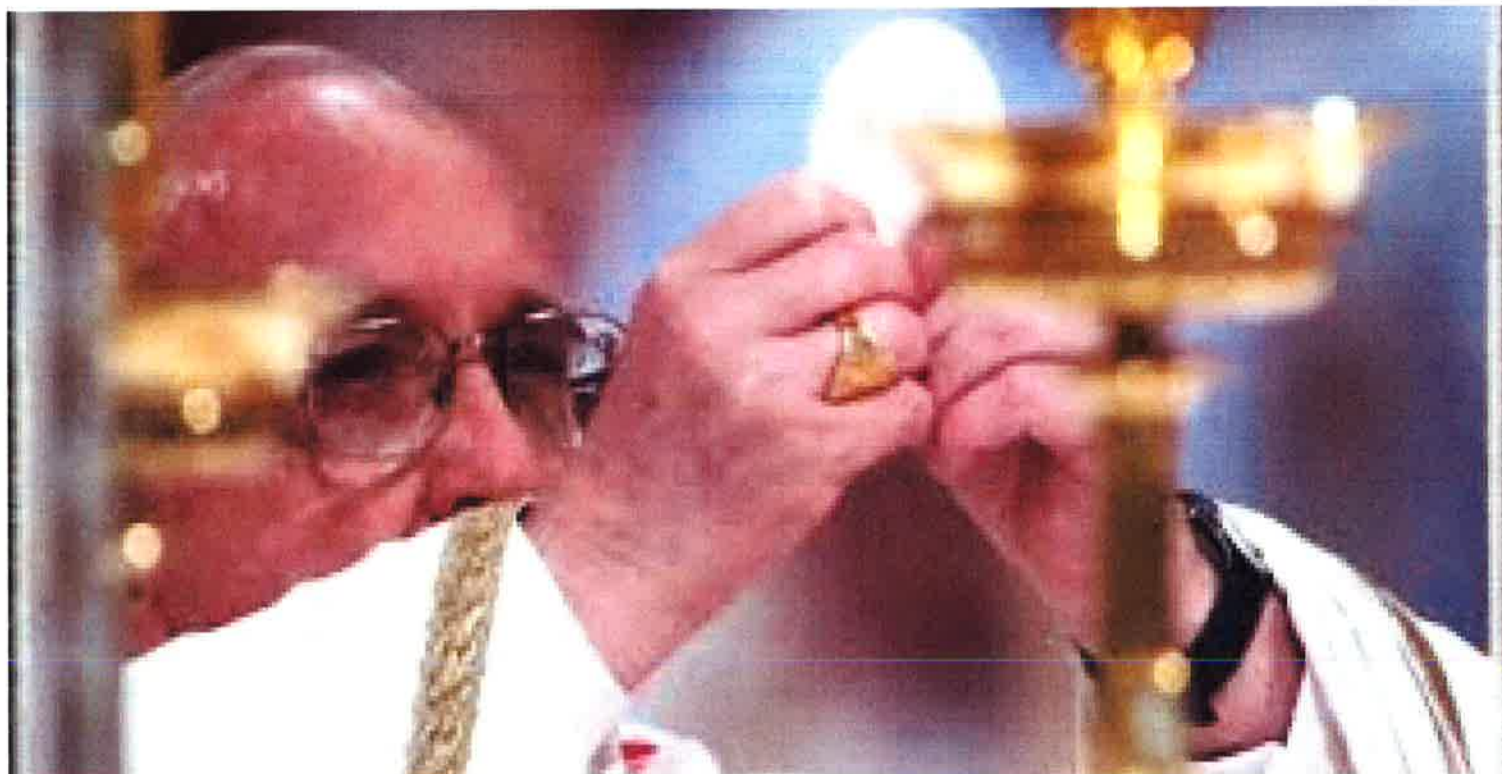

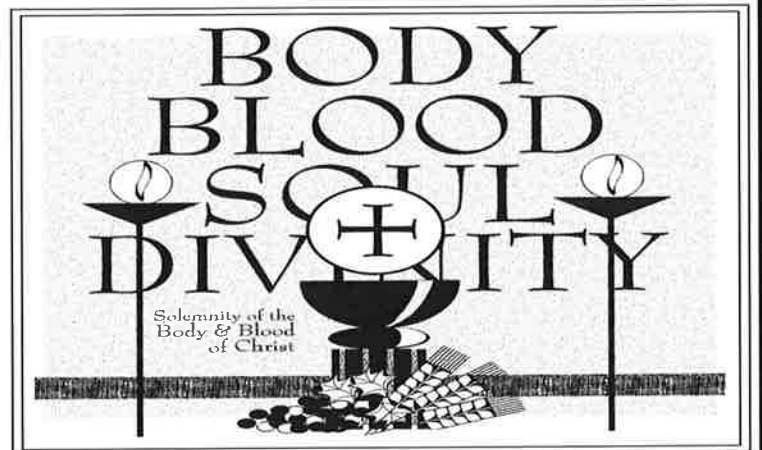

Room in the Inn – Fall 2016

Every year on the Sundays from November to March, Our Lady of the Lake hosts 15 homeless men from the Room in the Inn program. This is a big program that takes many volunteers. The main person that headed the program for our church has decided to step down. This year we will be changing how we run the Room in the Inn program with our volunteers just a bit. In efforts to make the Room in the Inn not be such a burden on those involved, we will divide out the main responsibilities as follows:

Room in the Inn Director – this person will be in charge overall, all managers will report to the director. The director is also in charge of main communications regarding the program to the church, to the Social Action chair and with Room in the Inn in Nashville. He/she will also be responsible for arranging the bus/transportation for the Room in the Inn guests and handle the background checks on all volunteers.

Innkeeper manager – this person will be in charge of recruiting, training and maintaining the innkeeper staff at all Room in the Inn weekends. All innkeepers will report to this person for any issues in scheduling.

Teams manager – this person will be in charge of recruiting and building teams, and creating schedules. All student helpers will also report to this person and must sign up at the beginning of the season to help. Only those that have signed up will be allowed be scheduled.

Donations manager - this person will be in charge of all donations including clothing, toiletries, food such as coffee and sausage from the religious education classes.

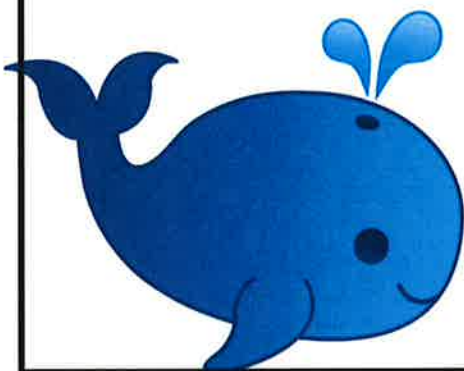

Jubilee Year of Mercy

May 29, 2016

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ
 (Corpus Christi)

In this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, the Lectionary's Year of Luke presents a Gospel in which Jesus, who has welcomed, taught, healed, and shown God's mercy to the multitude, refuses the Twelve's demand to dismiss the crowd before him. Instead, he says, "Give them some food yourselves" (Luke 9:13). In Jesus' hands, what little the Twelve has feeds five thousand ("men," and probably as many women and children), leaving twelve baskets so the Twelve can continue Jesus' ministry of mercy. Pope Francis has asked how *we* celebrate and live the Eucharist. Do we keep it to ourselves? Or do we "commune" not only with Jesus but with the multitude whom Jesus has given us to cherish? Entrusted to Jesus and shared with others, our limited resources can go a long way. Recognizing Jesus in the Eucharist demands that we recognize Jesus also in the hungry crowd. Adoring Jesus present in the Eucharist requires that we serve Jesus present in our neighbor.

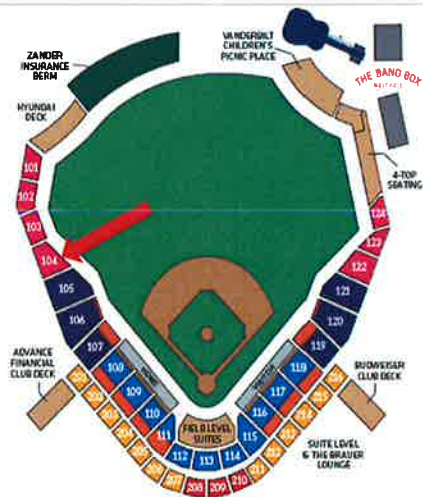
