Room in the Inn – Fall 2016

Every year on the Sundays from November to March, Our Lady of the Lake hosts 15 homeless men from the Room in the Inn program. This is a big program that takes many volunteers. The main person that headed the program for our church has decided to step down. This year we will be changing how we run the Room in the Inn program with our volunteers just a bit. In efforts to make the Room in the Inn not be such a burden on those involved, we will divide out the main responsibilities as follows:

Room in the Inn Director – this person will be in charge overall, all managers will report to the director. The director is also in charge of main communications regarding the program to the church, to the Social Action chair and with Room in the Inn in Nashville. He/she will also be responsible for arranging the bus/transportation for the Room in the Inn guests and handle the background checks on all volunteers.

Innkeeper manager – this person will be in charge of recruiting, training and maintaining the innkeeper staff at all Room in the Inn weekends. All innkeepers will report to this person for any issues in scheduling.

Teams manager – this person will be in charge of recruiting and building teams, and creating schedules. All student helpers will also report to this person and must sign up at the beginning of the season to help. Only those that have signed up will be allowed be scheduled.

Donations manager - this person will be in charge of all donations including clothing, toiletries, food such as coffee and sausage from the religious education classes.

Jubilee Year of Mercy

June 12, 2016

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

On today's *Jubilee for Those Sick and Suffering Disabilities*, Jesus encounters a woman who is "spiritually ill." She is thus "disabled" from participating in Israel's worshiping community or polite society. Bathing Jesus' feet with tears, drying them with unveiled hair, anointing them (Luke 7:38) risk Jesus' becoming "unclean." Yet his mercy welcomes even such inappropriate behavior as her sincere manifestation of love: "Your sins are forgiven. Go in peace" (7:48, 50). Go not just in "peace," but in *shalom*, the all-enveloping, life-changing assurance of God's mercy. She is anonymous, "known in the city" only as "a sinful woman" (7:37). The character with name and religious title, "Simon the Pharisee" (7:36, 40), judges her harshly, but himself not at all, and thus forfeits God's mercy. This *Jubilee Year of Mercy* challenges us to self-examination. In which role do we most often cast ourselves, humble sinner or judgmental Pharisee? Jesus declares that only by an unflinching willingness to show mercy to fellow sinners can we hope to obtain mercy ourselves (see *Misericordiae Vultus*, 9).
