Dear Parents,

God bless you for bringing your child to the point where, together, you will consider his/her readiness for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

You were the one who brought your child to the Church for Baptism. Again, you respond to Christ's invitation to gather around the table of the Lord and helped prepare your child to share in the bread and wine, the body and blood of Jesus. Both of these sacraments celebrate stages of initiation into our Catholic Christian Community. Now your son/daughter is ready to begin preparation which will complete the initiation. Confirmation celebrates and increases the awareness of the presence of the Spirit in his/her life.

Your child's Baptism and First Eucharist provided an opportunity for you to consider the importance of the sacramental life of the Church in your family. This time of preparation for Confirmation invites you to reflect further.

Confirmation practice and Confirmation dates will be announced as soon as our scheduled date from the Diocese is available 3910The Sponsor is required to attend the rehearsal. If the candidates sponsor is not able to attend, at least one parent is required to attend the rehearsal.

All students seeking Confirmation should complete at least two years of Religious Education prior to the sacramental year to be fully prepared.

All students preparing for Confirmation are required to attend classes weekly. More than **five** absences will likely result in delay of the sacrament.

I have prayerfully considered the decision to encourage my child to enter the Confirmation preparation process. I commit myself to work with my child in exploring the weekly scriptures and identifying the people who exemplify the Gifts of the Spirit. I will encourage my son/daughter to complete all the Confirmation requirements on time.
